

ACKC Clay Studio Protocols

We are delighted to be welcoming students back to the clay studio! Please carefully read the protocols so that you will be prepared.

Take your temperature before coming to class. If you have a fever, do not come.

Class sizes are limited: Only students and staff may enter the studio- no parents, children or visitors

Masks are required at all times

When entering the studio, sanitize or wash your hands

- Hand sanitizer, soap, paper towels and other sanitizers will be available in the studio

Students are asked to keep appropriate distance from each other and observe distancing guides on the floor

- Wheels and tables are appropriately spaced
- One student per table
- One student at a time may: use the sinks, slab roller, extruder, go into the student shelf room, or kiln room
- If you need to have a snack, go out on the porch

Sanitizing

- Students must sanitize or wash their hands after using shared equipment: i.e. slab roller, extruder, banding wheel.
- Students will sanitize the wheel and any studio tools they use, as part of the standard cleaning of tables, wheels, tools and floors at the end of each class.

Students must bring:

- Masks- No masks will be supplied.
- Personal hand sanitizer to keep on your work table
- Returning students must have their own tools, sponges, spray bottle and drycleaning plastic for working on and wrapping clay

The above protocols may be revised to be in keeping with CDC, state and local guidelines concerning Covid-19.
