Cleaning Protocol

The Arts Center of Kershaw County is dedicated to making sure all areas are properly sanitized following CDC guidelines with the use of EPA approved cleaning products, including Clorox Clean-Up, Lysol disinfectant, and an alcohol-based solution for glass and other bleach sensitive objects. Proper use and disposal of gloves and trash are always followed. Staff and volunteers will sanitize their hands a minimum of once every 30 minutes. The facility will be properly sanitized prior to each event following the guidelines for cleaning set by the Center for Disease Control. Drinking fountains are not available for use. Bathrooms with multiple stalls are not to exceed more than two people that are not members of the same family.

Additional sanitation will be implemented during events on a case by case basis keeping in compliance guidelines set by the Center for Disease Control.

Daily/Weekly Cleaning:

- Clean and sanitize all high touch surfaces daily
- Clean restrooms: doors, handles, toilets, sinks and light switches
- Clean box office window, & counter
- Refill paper products and soaps for handwashing
- Pull trash and disinfect trash can lids
- Spot vacuum the common areas as needed
- Sweep & mop as needed
- Dust wood furnishings (weekly or before events)
- Sanitization stations will be accessible

Examples of high touch surfaces and objects as stated by the CDC that will need routine disinfection following reopening are:

Tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, sinks, and touch screens
