

Music Studio Covid-19 Protocols

- No money will be collected by the music teacher to prevent spreading of the virus. Payments should be made online or at the front office.
- If you do not feel well, stay home. Better safe than sorry. Parents - please take your child's temperature before coming to your lesson. If they have fever, or are feeling sick, please do not attend lesson.
- Students must wear a mask during lesson. (must be their own mask; no masks will be provided).
- Voice and Wind instrument lessons will be virtual for now.
- If possible, please have minors use the bathroom before coming to class.
- There will be a limited number of students allowed in the building at a time to provide for social distancing. Only students and staff may enter the studio - no parents, siblings, or visitors.
- Students should enter the music studio through the door closest to the parking lot and exit through the door on the far end and down the middle steps to the brick pathway.
- When entering the studio, students will sanitize their hands. (hand sanitizer will be available in the studio.)
- Avoid unnecessary touching, movement or singing that might increase the transmission of aerosol droplets.
- Shared instruments, such as the piano will be disinfected between students.
- Student should not bring extra materials into the studio, just what is needed such as mask, music, instrument, phone, keys, wallet, and water bottle if needed. Water Bottle should be marked with their name.
